Our volunteer vision screeners are comprised of individuals from the community, as well as from McMaster University, such as students from various programs (Health Science, Life Science, Arts, etc.). Vision screeners are trained to carry out vision screening tests on children through theoretical and practical training modules. Prior to being able to screen children in schools independently, the competence of each vision screener is assessed by both a paediatric ophthalmologist and our partner optometrists.

Being a vision screener is a rewarding endeavour, as our volunteers constantly receive direct feedback from schools regarding the importance of the service they provide.
